Electric Heater Safety Tips

Portable electrical space heaters can be a convenient way of providing extra warmth in your home. Unfortunately, they can also pose significant fire and electric shock hazards if they are not used properly.

Here's a few tips to help you use electric space heaters safely.

Things you should do

- Make sure your heater has a label that shows it is certified as safe.
- Read the manufacturer's instructions and warning labels carefully.
- Inspect your heater for cracked and broken plugs or loose connections before each use.
 If frayed, worn or damaged do not use.
- Place your heater on a stable and flat surface where there is minimum risk of it being knocked over.
- Keep your heater at least 1 meter away from things that can easily catch fire such as clothes, curtains, rugs, furniture and you.

Remember!


You should have a smoke alarm in your home and you should be testing it weekly.

Get it. Install it. Check it.

Smoke alarms save lives.


Things you shouldn't do

- **DO NOT** put anything flammable around the front, sides or rear of your heater.
- DO NOT use an extension cord or power strip unless you absolutely have to. These could cause the plug in wall socket to overheat and cause a fire.
- If you have to use an extension cable or power strip - never overload by plugging in appliances that together will exceed maximum rating stated for the extension lead



KNOW THE LIMIT!

$$5 + 5 + 3 = 13$$





- **DO NOT** place the heater on top of a table, chair or any other surface that is not stable.
- DO NOT operate your heater near water, anything that is damp or if you're wet.
- **DO NOT** run the power cord from your heater underneath carpets, rugs or furniture.
- DO NOT use the heater to dry clothes, warm bedding, cook food or thaw pipes.
- **DO NOT** leave the heater on whilst sleeping.
- DO NOT leave children, the elderly or those with impaired mobility unattended around the heater.
